





Five Year Tax Rate Trend—School District



Five Year Tax Rate Trend—County





Five Year Tax Rate Trend—Town




Combined School, County, and Town— Five Year Tax Rate Trend










Five Year Trend—Public Safety Fund Expenditures (\$ Millions)




2014 Public Safety Cost (excluding benefits) Per Capita

Five Year Trend—Highway Fund Expenditures (\$ Millions)




2014 Transportation Activity Cost (excluding benefits) Per Capita


