Precision Trenchless has completed the 24" cured-in-place pipe rehabilitation for the degraded storm system on Amanda Ln. and Amelia Dr. The project was the first use of the CIPP lining method for the Town of Orchard Park and was successfully implemented. By embracing this form of construction, the Town saved an estimated \$91,000 compared to the Highway Dept. estimate of \$150,000 for a traditional open cut replacement.

- I, therefore, recommend that you adopt the following Resolutions:
 - 1. Approve the final payment of \$59,881.75 (P.O. No.2000999) to Precision Trenchless LLC., 1710 Erie Boulevard, Schenectady, NY 12308, for the Amelia Dr. and Amanda Ln. Storm Sewer Relining Rehabilitation Project.

Award of Bid - Green Lake Maintenance Dredging Project

Dear Board Members:

Bids were opened for the Green Lake Maintenance Dredging Project on October 19, 2020 at 10:00 AM. The project was bid, as requested, with the base bid being the removal of sediment from the weir at Green Lake and included an alternate to dredge +/-1,100CY from Acorn Cir. Pond. The bid results are attached. The Engineering Department has reviewed the bids and conducted de-scoping meetings with the two lowest bidders.

Legend Excavating is the apparent low bidder with a submitted Base Bid for \$47,500 and a cost to complete Alternate #1 for \$16,000. After meeting with Legend Excavating, and consulting neighboring municipal references, Legend has established their capability to complete the project as bid and I have no reservations about their ability.

The Engineering Dept. is continuing to work with the DEC and the neighboring owners of the Acorn Cir. Pond to receive all necessary permits as well as establish payment responsibilities. While we cannot move forward with the Alternate to dredge Acorn Cir. Pond at this time, Legend Excavating has agreed to hold their bid price until the end of 2021. (attached)

Ed Leak has provided two Parks & Grounds accounts with sufficient funding to cover the costs associated with this project. Money within the accounts was earmarked for the purchase of a Ventrac mower and pickup truck but have not been approved by the Board per Ed Leak, Parks and Grounds Department.

I, therefore, recommend that you adopt the following Resolutions:

- 1. Approve the creation of capital account #AP013 Green Lake Maintenance Dredging.
- 2. Authorize the Transfer of \$5,800 from #A07110-50544 Lake Maintenance and Chanel cleaning, Yates Park to Account #AP013.
- 3. Authorize the Transfer of \$49,200 from #A07110-50200 Parks Equipment, to Account #AP013.
- 4. Award the contract for the Green Lake Dam Maintenance Dredging Project to the lowest responsible bidder, Legend Excavating, 8080 Barnum Road, Cassadaga, New York 1718 in the amount not to exceed \$47,500.00.

Dear Board Members:

New York's State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQR) requires all state and local government agencies to consider environmental impacts equally with social and economic factors during discretionary decision-making. The Town must assess the environmental significance of all actions they have discretion to approve, fund or directly undertake.

The Orchard Park Engineering Department has attached the SEQR Short Form for the Acorn Circle Pond Maintenance Dredging Project and has determined the project is classified as a "Type II Action" in accordance with section 617.5 (c)(8) of the SEQR regulations as maintenance of existing landscaping or natural growth. Actions that are classified as "Type II Actions" under the SEQR regulations do not require any further SEQR review, including an Environmental Assessment Form. The Short Environmental Assessment Form has been completed and is attached to provide documentation of this review and determination.

Along with completing the SEQR requirements, a joint application for permit will is required to be submitted to the NYSDEC and ACOE. The draft application is attached and requires a \$200 application fee.

I, therefore, recommend that you adopt the following resolutions:

1) Determine the Acorn Circle Maintenance Dredging Project is classified as a "Type II Action" as the project will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment and is precluded from further environmental review under Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law and 6 NYCRR Part 617.

2) Authorize the Deputy Supervisor to sign the Joint application for permit for the USACOE and NYSDEC for the Acorn Circle Maintenance Dredging Project.
