As discussed, consultant assistance is needed for the Town of Orchard Park with application for funding through the CFA Planning Grant Program.

With the engineering firm of C&S Company being involved with the NYBridge culvert application, they were the selected consultant for the CFA Funding Application Program. J.O. Connell Associates and I have met with representatives of that firm to review contract language, refined the scope of services to determine in advance the need for additional services and optional service elements, which may be required on this project. The Town will provide existing complaint files, drainage shed maps, identified options to address flooding as well as investigation work, preliminary design work, dewatering /televising of existing outlet culvert condition. See attachment for tasks included in the scope of work of the agreement.

There is presently \$68,759.00 plus interest allocated under Capital Project DB002, Bridge Emergency Repairs for funding.
