ADULT BOOKSTORE

An establishment having as a substantial or significant portion of its stock-in-trade books, magazines, films for sale or viewing on premises, by use of motion-picture devices or any other coin-operated means, and other periodicals which are distinguished or characterized by their emphasis on matter depicting, describing or relating to specified sexual activities or specified anatomical areas, or an establishment with a segment or section devoted to the sale or display of such material.

ADULT ENTERTAINMENT CABARET

A public or private establishment which is licensed to serve food and/or alcoholic beverages, which features topless dancers, strippers, male or female impersonators or similar entertainers.

ADULT MINI-MOTION-PICTURE THEATER

An enclosed building with a capacity of less than 50 persons used for presenting material distinguished or characterized by an emphasis on matter depicting, describing or relating to specified sexual activities or specified anatomical areas for observation by patrons therein.

ADULT MOTION-PICTURE THEATER

An enclosed building with a capacity of 50 or more persons used regularly and routinely for presenting material having as a dominant theme material distinguished or characterized by an emphasis on matter depicting, describing or relating to specified sexual activities or specified anatomical areas for observation by patrons therein.

CANNABIS DISPENSARIES

A Fixed public or private establishment or facility, operated in accordance with New York state laws, local town laws and regulations where cannabis, and/or cannabis products are offered for retail sale.

PERSON

Any person, firm partnership, corporation, association or legal representative, acting individually or jointly.

SPECIFIED ANATOMICAL AREAS

Less than completely and opaquely covered human genitals, pubic region or female breast below a point immediately above the top of the areola; human male genitals in a discernibly turgid state, even if completely and opaquely covered.

SPECIFIED SEXUAL ACTIVITIES

Human genitals in a state of sexual stimulation or arousal; acts of human masturbation, sexual intercourse or sodomy; fondling or other erotic touching of human genitals, pubic region, buttock or female breast.

- B. Restrictions for Adult uses, including but not limited to adult bookstore, adult motion-picture theater, adult mini-motion-picture theater, adult entertainment cabaret and cannabis dispensaries, shall be permitted, subject to the following restrictions.
 - (1) No such adult use shall be allowed within 1,500 feet of another existing adult use.
 - (2) No such adult use shall be located within 1,500 feet of the boundaries of any zoning district which is zoned exclusively for residential use (those zones designated R-1, R-2, R-3 or R-4).
 - (3) No such adult use shall be located within 1,500 feet of an existing school or place of worship.
 - (4) Adult uses shall be classified as a special exception use in the I-1 District and shall not commence operation until securing a permit pursuant to Article VI of this chapter, entitled "Special Uses."
 - (5) Adult use hours of operation will be 10:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M.

C. Registration.

- (1) The owner of a building or premises, his agent for the purpose of managing or controlling or collecting rents or any other person managing or controlling a building or premises, any part of which contains an adult use, shall register the following information with the Town Clerk of the Town of Orchard Park:
 - (a) The address of the premises.

- (b) The name and address of the owner of the premises and the names and addresses of the beneficial owners if the property is in a land trust.
- (c) The name of the business or the establishment subject to the provisions of this section.
- (d) The name(s) and address(es) of the owner, beneficial owner or the major stockholder(s) of the business or the establishment subject to the provisions of this section.
- (e) The date of initiation of the adult use.
- (f) The nature of the adult use.
- (g) If the premises or building is leased, a copy of said lease.
- (2) It is a violation of this section for the owner or person in control of any property to establish or operate thereon or to permit any person to establish or operate thereon an adult use without having properly registered said adult use with the Town Clerk.
- D. Display of registration. The owner, manager or agent of a registered adult use shall display in a conspicuous place on the premises of the adult use a copy of the registration filed with the Town Clerk.
- E. Public observation prohibited. No adult use shall be conducted in any manner that permits the observation of any material depicting, describing or relating to specified sexual activities or specified anatomical areas from any public way or from any property not registered as an adult use. This provision shall apply to any display, decoration, sign, show window or other opening.

Dear Board Members:

The NYSLTAP-CLRP provides training, technical assistance and information to municipal agencies responsible for the maintenance, construction and management of local highways and bridges in New York State. The Town of Orchard Park currently uses their guidelines for our road assessment program. The Cornell Asset Management Program (CAMP) helps us implement a pavement management system for our highway network by collecting pavement inventory and condition data, and creating a five-year maintenance plan for our municipality. As you know, having current, accurate data when making decisions with allocating funding is critical. The Engineering Department, with the Highway Department, will be aggressively assessing our road infrastructure and providing this data for the Highway Superintendent over the next few months.

The Engineering Department and Highway Department are requesting to participate in pavement maintenance assessment training provided by CLRP. We are asking to utilize our training room located in the CAC and in exchange, receive training at no cost to Town of Orchard Park attendees. We understand that for the Town use, the fees associated with utilizing the training room are waived. CLRP is agreeable that approximately 3 employees to attend at no cost.

This training will be extremely beneficial to the Town of Orchard Park to assess our road infrastructure, and plan for the future maintenance plan to address failing road surfaces and drainage. It will be scheduled for April 26, 2022, from 8am to 5pm.

I, therefore, recommend the authorization to use a meeting room at the Community Activity Center for 30-40 people for a pavement maintenance assessment training program.

Cured-In-Place Sanitary Sewer Pipe lining Contract

Dear Board Members:

The SW&L Department is continuing to perform video inspections of the Town's sanitary sewer infrastructure. United Survey Inc. was awarded a contract to perform Cured-In-Place Pipe Lining throughout various areas in the Town. The contract was awarded as a bid through the Erie County Division of Purchasing Contract #217039-002. The areas are being identifies through video inspections performed by the SW&L Department and prioritized by SW&L Department and the Engineering Department. The Town has lined over ±11,864 LF to date.

The following two Work Orders are complete:

- Work Order #1, released in September 2020 to rehabilitate the sanitary main on the west side of North Benzing Road (2,643 LF). Cost of Work Order #1 was \$83,888.
- Work Order #2 released in February 2021 to rehabilitate the sanitary main on a portion of Bussendorfer Road (3,454 LF), California Road between Duerr Road and Armor Duells Road (1,363 LF), and a portion of Duerr Road (327 LF). Cost of Work Order #2 was \$180,986.

Work Order #3 released in August 2021 to rehabilitate the sanitary mains on Shultz Road (874 LF), Meadowlawn Road (1,754 LF) and Middlesex Road (1,449 LF), all these roads are off Abbott Road. There remains a portion of Work Order #3 not complete. This area is located on Southwestern Boulevard between Mid County Drive and Pleasant Avenue (3,308 LF). This work has started and is scheduled to be completed.

The contract amount completed/paid to date for Work Order #3 is \$132,239. This amount does not include the work on Southwestern Boulevard (3,308 LF). The anticipated cost to complete the Southwestern Boulevard section is \$106,131. This brings the total contract amount for Work Order #1, 2, & 3 to \$503,244.

The Engineering Department has assembled and is recommending the release of Work Order #4. This work order will include the following streets:

- Forsythia Court, ±983 LF of Vitrified Clay Pipe (VCP),
- Red Fox Lane +/-1293 LF of Vitrified Clay Pipe (VCP),
- Willowbrook Drive +/-191 LF of Vitrified Clay Pipe (VCP),

- Webster Road (south side) ±4929 LF of Asbestos Cement Pipe (ACP),
- Webster Road (north side) ±1662 LF of Asbestos Cement Pipe (ACP),
- Deacon Street ±794 LF of Asbestos Cement Pipe (ACP),
- North Buffalo Street (west side) ±1554 LF of Asbestos Cement Pipe (ACP).

The section lined on Webster Road runs between Breem Street east to North Buffalo Street. This section has experienced major repairs over the last several years.

The section on North Buffalo Street runs from Webster Road south to Holland Lane. The sewer main is located in a wooded area that is only accessible from the backyards of the homes and from parking lots of business on North Buffalo Street.

This section will require additional work by the contractor to access and will require an additional expense to line this portion of sewer main. This work scope is not included with the County of Erie contract. The extra cost will be added to the final proposal for Work Order #4 and is estimated at \$4,500.

The total cost of Work Order #4 is \$404,786.50 and the cost of the additional work on North Buffalo Street is \$4,500.00 for a total of \$409,286.5. This will bring the current contract expenditures to \$912,530.50, roughly 91% of the authorized original contract amount.

Once work commences on Work Order #4, we will begin to assemble Work Order #5 lining projects targeting older, smaller neighborhoods within District 18 Oakwood, Allen, Glen, and other areas of need. As you know, some of the older neighborhoods in need of rehabilitation are part of smaller sanitary sewer district, and no work is currently being proposed within the small districts due to the pending consolidation of all Town Sanitary Sewer Districts. Once the consolidation process is completed, we will look to begin work in these areas.

There is presently funding allocated under Capital Project G0007 \$1,515,000, "Sanitary Sewer Main Televising and Relining" for this work.

I, therefore, recommend that you adopt the following resolution to approve Work Order #4 for the CIPP Rehabilitation contract with United Survey Inc., 25145 Broadway Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44146, in the amount not to exceed \$409,286.50.

I, therefore, recommend that you award the contract for Hydrant Replacement at 5112 Bussendorfer Road to the lowest responsible bidder, Fairway Contracting, PO Box 352, Orchard Park, NY 14127 in an amount not to exceed \$13,449.43.
