

Dear Board Members:

The Engineering Department is requesting your approval of a Change Order (attached) to the contract with Union Concrete & Construction Corporation for the Bussendorfer Drainage Improvements Phase 2 Project in the amount of \$9,000.00. If approved, this would increase the total contract amount to \$1,004,187.88, representing an increase of 0.009%.

The Change Order requested is to revise the work scope under their contract to address several drainage issues and deteriorated pipe replacement. In the area of the project, an existing Pinewood Drive 15" cross culvert's invert is rotten and non-existent. Also, to address a drainage issue for the discharge of a home's sump and downspouts from 4985 Bussendorfer, a far side 6-inch lateral drain pipe with a bubbler is needed. Both of these items were requested to be added to this project by the OP Highway Superintendent.

There is presently funding under AD002 Bussendorfer Drainage \$839,781, but additional funding is needed and a meeting is scheduled with accounting.
