Dear Board Members:

As you may know, the NYSDOT is planning safety improvements to the intersection of Orchard Park / North Buffalo Road (NY Rte. 240/277) and Milestrip Road (US Rte. 20A). The DOT is planning on widening the intersection area and adding turning lanes. NYSEG owns the utility poles along the roads which will be affected by the project. The Town is responsible for the lights and brackets on those poles.

The State's policy is to replace or make adjustments to any utilities owned by a municipality which are in conflict with highway construction work, at no expense to the municipality. The NYSDOT requires the municipality to sign a utility work agreement, which authorizes such work. The agreement also provides for the State to reimburse the municipality for any costs the municipality incurs associated with such utility modifications.

For the Orchard Park / North Buffalo Road (Rte. 240/277) and Milestrip Road (Rte. 20A) Project, the Town of Orchard Park owned luminaires and bracket arms are in conflict with the proposed highway construction work, and will be relocated by NYSDOT, at no expense to the Town.

On December 22nd, 2022, we received a letter from NYSDOT requesting that the Town sign the necessary utility work agreements and return them by January 19, 2023. The documents will then be forwarded to Albany for review and approval by NYSDOT's legal staff so that the road reconstruction project can remain on schedule.

I, therefore, recommend that you adopt the following resolution to Authorize the Supervisor to sign the HC140 Utility Work Agreement (4 copies) with the New York State Department of Transportation for the NY Rte.240/277 @ Milestrip Road (US Route 20A) Project (P.I.N. #5814.39) permitting the relocation of luminaries and bracket arms at no expense to the Town of Orchard Park. The State also requires four (4) certified copies of a resolution (example attached) that the Town will maintain the improvements. The Town Supervisor has the authority to sign documents in regards to this project and four (4) certified copies will be forwarded to the NYSDOT.

Dear Board Members:

The map, plan and report for the proposed Town Wide Stormwater Management District prepared by GHD in accordance with Article 12 of the Town Law is now available at the Town Clerk's office for public review.

The Town has provided stormwater infrastructure management and services for a considerable length of time. However, over the last 19 years, the Town was required to comply with Federal and State regulations and laws which has increased the cost of providing these services. Under the NYSDEC general stormwater permit for Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4), the Town is required to maintain a stormwater management program (six minimum controls) to reduce the amount of pollutants carried by stormwater during storm events, to waterbodies, to the maximum extent practicable. Additional quantity and quality control measures, codes, standards and specifications were therefore implemented. The creation of individual drainage districts was also necessary to address the additional infrastructure maintenance cost. The current 22 individual drainage districts in Orchard Park were formed per Town Law Section 191. All of these individual districts will be dissolved with the formation of a Town Wide Stormwater Management District.

The current method of funding for stormwater is the general fund, highway fund, and the individual drainage districts, which, are currently inadequate to maintain and improve the aging stormwater infrastructure. Furthermore, the proposed Federal and State regulations will increase the Town's future funding needs in order to meet these mandates.

Current Town Infrastructure includes storm sewer pipes, catch basins, manholes, culvert pipes, swirl chambers, and retention/detention basins/ponds. The Town has approximately 195 miles of stormwater drain pipe ranging in size from 6 to 72 inches, 110 miles at total center line of medsite the Town and 30 6 miles of ditches along

public roads. There are 54 publicly owned and operated detention basins/ponds and 28 private detention basins/ponds including 100 inlet/outlet structures. The Town has 335 identified outfalls.

The establishment of a publicly funded Stormwater Management District is in the best interest of the residents. The district will service the entire Town (excluding the Village) with the required management and funding to control water quality and quantity per the Federal EPA Environmental Law, the Clean Water Act and Stormwater Phase II regulations, while also address aging infrastructure maintenance and replacement.

- I, therefore, recommend that you adopt the following resolutions:
 - Accept the map, plan and report in accordance with Section 191 of the Town Law for the establishment of the Stormwater Management District
 SMD 1.
 - Authorize the scheduling of a Public Hearing on the creation of a Town Wide Stormwater Management District at your regular meeting of February 15, 2023 at 7:00pm.
