Subdivision 5-a of New York State Real Property Tax Law 467 and Subdivision 6-e of RPTL 425 states an application for a tax exemption may be filed with the assessor after taxable status day (not later than Grievance Day), where failure to file a timely application resulted from the death of the applicant's spouse, child, parent, brother or sister or an illness of the applicant or of the applicant's spouse, child, parent, brother or sister, which actually prevents the applicant from filing on a timely basis, as certified by a licensed physician. The assessor shall approve or deny such application as if it had been filed on or before the taxable status date. Completion of this form by a MD or DO will satisfy this requirement.
