(Insite) to place an advertisement per National Flood Insurance Program 65.7(b)(1) for intent to revise the flood hazard information generally located between Lake Avenue and the Hammocks Drive, along Smokes Creek approximately 650-feet upstream from Orchard Park road to just downstream of Southwestern Boulevard. This revision of the flood hazard information at this location for the Aldi's commercial development in this area. Insite will reimburse the Town for the cost of the attached advertisement.

Lakeview Reconstruction Project - Bid Award

Dear Board Members:

Bids were opened for the Lakeview Reconstruction Project on November 28, 2023. The project consists of total reconstruction/replacement of Storm Sewers, Waterlines, and Roadway, and partial reconstruction/replacement of the Sanitary Sewers.

The project was bid on a unit price basis for the associated waterline, sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and road restoration work items. The Engineering Department has reviewed those itemized prices of the four contractors who submitted bids. The Project also included two Alternates for cold milling the roadway and construction of a Park maintenance driveway and parking lot. This area can be used as a staging area for the current project and for future highway snow storage as well as various park uses. The Orchard Park Engineering Department performed a review of the four bids submitted, and compared them against the Engineer's estimate of \$3,890,229.68. The lowest responsible bidder with base bid and the two alternates is \$3,787,258.60. As discussed, the low bidder does switch from Occhino Corporation if Alternates #1 and #2 are awarded. Both Occhino Corporation and Edbauer Construction reference checks were very positive and could complete the project.

Attached is an extended tabulation of bid results showing the itemized bid amounts from each bidder. Contractor submissions were checked for math errors. No errors were identified. The lowest responsible bidder was McLaughlin Construction Corp. DBA Edbauer Construction (Edbauer Construction) for \$3,787,258.60 with A1 and A2 Alternatives.

There is presently approximately 2,791,397 plus interest allocated under Capital Accounting Projects, Lakeview HWY DB008, Lakeview Water FX011 and Lakeview Sanitary Sewer G0011 for this project work. An additional \$995,861.60 is recommended. This includes \$100,000.00 contingency and typically a unit price bid does not cost 100 % of contract.

Edbauer Construction has successfully completed various storm sewer, water, sanitary sewer, and road reconstruction projects in the past. The contractor provided references on relevant experience and all gave positive comments.

1, therefore, recommend that you adopt the following resolutions:

- 1) Award the contract for the Lakeview Reconstruction Project to the lowest responsible bidder, Edbauer Construction, 2790 Clinton Street, West Seneca, New York 14224 in the amount not to exceed \$3,787,258.60 (Base Bid and A1 & A2 Alternates).
- 2) Authorize the additional drawdown of \$995,862 from Highway bond funding approved but not issued on December 15, 2021.

Dear Board Members:

As you may already know, over the years, there has been an increase in traffic patterns through the North Benzing and Lake Avenue intersection. Many residence have also called to complain about the amount of time it take to make a left turn onto Lake Avenue from North Benzing. The residents are requesting that the signal be change from flashing yellow to 3 phase. Even through the signal is on a County Highway, it is owned and maintained be the Town of Orchard Park. In order to change its function, a traffic study needs to be conducted. Once the study is complete, it needs to be reviewed and approved by Erie County Department of Public Work. The cost of the review permit is \$600.00.

Funding is allocated under Account BO3310 50444, "Traffic Control Contractual Expenses".

- I, therefore, recommend that you adopt the following resolutions:
 - 1) Authorize the Supervisor to sign the agreement with Passero Engineering Architecture, 242 West Main Street, Suite 100, Rochester, NY 14614, to provide professional services for a traffic study in the amount not to exceed \$8,200.00.
 - 2) Authorize payment of the associate ECDPW application permit in the amount of \$600.00.



EXTRACT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE ERIE COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY NOVEMBER 16, 2023

At a regular meeting of the Erie County Water Authority held in the office, 295 Main Street, Room 350, Buffalo, New York, on the 16th day of November 2023, a quorum being present, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the Act creating the Erie County Water Authority (the "Authority") and the General Bond Resolutions establishing issuance of all Authority bonds mandate: that the Authority maintain rates and fees sufficient to operate and maintain the waterworks system; to pay the principal and interest on its Revenue Bonds as they become due and payable; and to maintain reserves for capital improvements as well as for all obligations and indebtedness of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Executive and Senior Staff have the responsibility to review, analyze and make recommendations relative to charges and procedures contained in the Authority's Tariff; and

WHEREAS, Terrence D. McCracken, Secretary to the Authority, Mark S. Carney, General Counsel, Joyce A. Tomaka, Chief Financial Officer and Charles E. Eaton, Chief Operating Officer have reviewed the above recommendations and changes and concur with them; and

WHEREAS, after considering all the above recommendations, the Authority has determined that for the best interest of the public to maintain its quality water supply that the Tariff should be amended as set forth in the attached Schedule "A";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Authority's Tariff, as previously amended, is hereby revised and amended in accordance with Schedule "A" attached hereto and made part hereof, to become effective at 12:01 a.m. January 1, 2024; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Secretary to the Authority is hereby authorized and directed to file in the office of the Clerk of the County of Erie a duly certified copy of this resolution along with a copy of the revised pages to the Tariff and to publish a copy of these amendments authorizing the abovementioned changes in two newspapers having a general circulation in the County pursuant to Section 1054, Subdivision 10, of the Public Authorities Law; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Secretary to the Authority, is further directed to forward a copy of this resolution along with a copy of the revised pages of the Tariff to the Town, Village or City Clerks of each of the towns, villages or cities receiving water from the Authority and that the Secretary to the Authority is further directed to furnish a duly certified copy of this resolution along with a copy of the revised pages of the Tariff to all Fiscal Agents named in the Authority's Bond Resolutions; and be it further

RESOLVED: The Board of Commissioners directs the Secretary of the Authority to post the amended Tariff on the Authority's website.

A motion was made by Ms. LaGree, seconded by Ms. Iannello and carried to adopt the foregoing resolution.
