



Dear Board Members:

I am pleased to inform you that construction work the on Bussendorfer Road Waterline Replacement Project has been completed. On October 18, 2022, a final inspection was conducted and all of the work has since been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the contract documents and specifications.

A two-year maintenance bond, in the amount of \$554,548.20, has been submitted along with the Affidavit of Release of Liens, Affidavit of Subcontractor Payment, and necessary legal documents.

Attached is a copy of the final project Change Order and associated Over/Under sheet. The Over/Under sheet lists the final adjustments to the quantities for each bid item and shows there will be a net decrease of \$153,659.87. This represents a decrease of 20.91% from the original amount bid with change orders.



On January 18, 2024, final inspection was conducted of the public improvement to relocate a watermain to facilitate the Birdsong Part 6 Subdivision off Old Transit Road.

The project consists of the relocation of 285 L.F. of an existing 12-inch diameter watermain along Old Transit Road do to proposed grades for the 4 residential sublots as shown on the attached location map and cover concerns. ECWA had a concern regarding a possible leak with water coming up but digging and testing proved it was just groundwater. 

The Engineering Department is requesting your approval of Change Order #1 to the Contract with C&S Company's, for Design of the Dennis Road Culvert Preplacement Project.

C&S Company's is requesting a \$26,000 (maximum amount payable) increase to their agreement to cover additional work not included within their original scope of work. This includes, additional ROW mapping and appraisal services, streambank armoring on private property, traffic counts, and landscaping, etc. per NYSDOT design report comments.

If approved, this change order would increase the Contract amount to \$188,000 from \$162,000, representing an increase of 16%. There is a Capital Account DB015 Dennis Road Culvert setup, which per accounting, will track all project costs under Capital Project DB015, Dennis Road Culvert Replacement Project for 100% reimbursement with the BridgeNY Culvert Program.

WHEREAS, wind energy has been designated by the Climate Act as an essential form of renewable energy; and

WHEREAS, there are a number of commercial wind energy facilities operating in Western New York, with more in the planning and permitting stages; and

WHEREAS, NY State's power grid manager New York Independent Systems Operator(NYISO) has determined the Western New York zone of grid to be 89 percent free of carbon emissions in the generation of electricity; (5), and

WHEREAS, NYISO has described the lack of electricity transmission facilities capable of transmitting electricity from Western New York to downstate grid zones which are 90 percent dependent on fossil fuels for generating electricity; (6), and

WHEREAS, the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority determined in 2022 that this is not the right time to consider constructing offshore wind facilities in Lake Erie; (7), and

WHEREAS, the offshore wind industry is experiencing global difficulties related to inflation and supply line shortages as evidenced by the recent NY State Public Service Commission decision denying industry requests for higher power delivery rates: (8), and

WHEREAS, the long planned Lake Erie offshore wind energy project known as Icebreaker Wind near Cleveland, Ohio, has recently been suspended (8a),

WHEREAS, questions concerning offshore wind energy facilities in fresh water bodies remain unanswered such as these which are not included in the NYSERDA reports of 2011 and 2022:


- What assurances that toxic industrial wastes in the lake bed will not be disturbed to endanger safe drinking water and enter the food chain of Lake Erie's fish and bird species (9)
- How would the placement of offshore wind turbines in Lake Erie affect the migratory pathways and behavior of economically important game fish (10)
- What would be the impact on tourism of placing wind turbines in Lake Erie (11)
- Specifically how would offshore wind turbines in Lake Erie contribute to the emissions reduction goals of the Climate Act (12)
- How would the radar interference created by offshore wind turbines in Lake Erie affect the safety of shipping, recreational boating, search and rescue operations and international border security (13)
- How would microplastics and toxic chemicals like BPA and PFAS emitted by wind turbines impact water quality and the ecology of Lake Erie (14)
- How much oil and other petroleum products are contained within each offshore wind turbine and how would oil spills from wind turbines be mediated, and other maintenance performed during annual periods of ice coverage on Lake Erie (15)
- How would noise and vibrations emitted by wind turbines impact the quiet enjoyment of Lake Erie by fishers, boaters and nearshore residents and visitors (16)
- What are the effects of vibrations emitted by wind turbines on the organisms living in the lake bed (17)
- How would the blinking red lights atop each offshore wind turbines be reconciled with increased interest in preventing light pollution in dark skies (18)
- What would be the impact of placing offshore wind turbines in Lake Erie's migratory flyways of birds, bats and butterflies (19)
- What are the cumulative impacts of placing offshore wind turbines in Lake Erie given the already large concentration of onshore wind turbines along the Ontario shoreline and the elevations overlooking the lake in Chautauqua County

- What restrictions or no-go zones would be imposed on fishers and boaters in Lake Erie (20)
- How would the Public Trust Doctrine which serves to protect the interests of all Western New Yorkers in a healthy Lake Erie be honored in the context of primary financial benefits to the offshore wind industry
- How would offshore wind turbines impact historic sites such as shipwrecks and lighthouses (21)
- Would the rights of the Seneca Nation of Indians to administer water quality standards on the Cattaraugus Reservation be a consideration in placing offshore wind turbines in Lake Erie (22)
- Would the high costs of offshore wind energy in Lake Erie be explained to Town of Hamburg electricity ratepayers in terms of monthly increases to their utility bills
- How would property values along the lake shore be impacted by viewsheds including offshore wind turbines and their industrial support and maintenance activities.
- Conclusion: Some of these questions cannot be answered, or would be cost prohibitive to address. There are many documented examples of negative impacts of wind turbines on both terrestrial and aquatic environments. There are alternatives such as small modular nuclear and hydropower, which deserve significant consideration as possible future sources of power and do not negatively affect Lake Erie or other large bodies of water.

Dear Board Members:

As you are aware from the traffic study, there has been an increase in traffic patterns through the North Benzing and Lake Avenue intersection. Other residences have also called to complain about the amount of time it takes to make a left turn onto Lake Avenue from North Benzing. Change the flashing yellow/red signal to a 3 phase signal may also reduce traffic toward Bieler Road by making a left turn easier. Even through the signal is on a County Highway, per NYS, it is owned and maintained by the Town of Orchard Park, Erie County does not own any signals. In order to change its function, a traffic study was conducted by Passero Engineering Architecture, (Which supported the signal change to 3 phases). The Orchard Park Engineering Department submitted it to the Erie County Department of Public Work. Subsequently, the study was approved by the Erie County Department of Public Work and the attached permit was sent.

Hence, attached is the permit, which the Town Supervisor needs to sign to physically start the work to change the signal from flashing yellow to 3 phase at Lake Avenue and North Benzing Road. In addition, per the April 10, 2024 email, the Orchard Park Highway Department is aware to coordinate with the Erie County Department of Public Work any and all field efforts, such as required signage, etc. to change the signal. I am of the understanding, a warning sign has to be placed a week before and for the first week with the 3 phase in place.

I, therefore, recommend that you adopt the following resolutions:

1) Authorize the Supervisor to sign the Erie County permit to change the signal from flashing yellow/red to 3 phase at Lake Avenue and North Benzing Road.

2) Authorize the Orchard Park Highway Department to coordinate with the Erie County Department of Public Work any and all field efforts to change the signal from flashing yellow to 3 phase at Lake Avenue and North Benzing Road.

Dear Board Members:

We have received a proposal from NYSEG for the installation of one (1) decorative street light fixture on Grove Road in the Riley Meadows West Subdivision, Phase 4. At present, there are twenty four (4) single-family homes currently under constructed in this Subdivision's Phase.

The LED luminaires infrastructure, which are owned and maintained by the Town, have been installed under PIP # 2023-01. The Town will maintain the poles, bulbs, and the electric eye of the luminaires and NYSEG will provide the energy only per the SC4 classification agreement. The Town purchases the electricity from the supplier, which is <u>estimated</u> to be \$42.03/ea. for an annual estimated cost of \$42.03 for this one decorative light pole. The attached application will add the new LED light to our existing SC4 (service classification) account. Charges for energy to the light may vary due to the electricity pricing trends from summer and winter month rate fluctuation.
